### Join us as we explore more effective coalition-building

Our speaker is Cate Fosl, a historian and the author of *Subversive Southerner: Anne Braden and the Struggle for Racial Justice in the Cold War South* and co-author of *Freedom on the Border: An Oral History of the Civil Rights Movement in Kentucky*. Dr. Fosl is an Associate Professor at the University of Louisville, where she also directs the Anne Braden Institute for Social Justice Research. **Dr. Fosl will be speaking on the topic: “Beyond the Oppression Olympics.”** She says: “In the 1980s, U.S. justice struggles were held back by internal divisions and even competition over which ‘ism’ (racism, sexism, militarism, etc.) should take priority. I’ll outline that history and use a few recent local examples to discuss its transformation into more effective coalition-building and ways of thinking about different systems of oppression more synergistically or intersectionally.”

**Dinner details:** The dinner is vegetarian. There will be ample vegan selections available. Children (12 or under) are free. For students or persons with low income, ticket prices are \$10. We ask all others to pay ticket prices on a sliding scale, \$15-50, according to ability to pay (the event cost will run approximately \$20 per person.
